It is possible for the check engine light to come on in Civic due to a loose or bad gas cap. The fuel system in modern vehicles is designed to maintain a certain level of pressure,and if the gas cap is not sealing properly,it can cause a leak and disrupt the pressure balance in the system.

A loose or damaged gas capis one of the most common and easily fixable causes of the check engine light coming on in a Honda or any other vehicle. The gas cap seals the fuel tank,preventing fuel vapors from escaping into the atmosphere. When the gas cap is loose or damaged,it allows fuel vapors to leak out,leading to an increase in emissions.
