What is the most famous chorus in Messiah?

Messiah is especially noted for its choruses. The most famous one is the "Hallelujah" chorus that ends Part Two.

How many movements are in Handel's Messiah?

Handel's Messiah is an oratorio in three parts with 53 separate movements. Each movement is listed below with a link to where that movement begins in the performance by The Tabernacle Choir and Orchestra at Temple Square with renowned guest soloists as streamed on Good Friday, April 10, 2020. (The original performance was at Easter in 2018.)

What is the structure of Handel's Messiah?

Handel's Messiah follows a three-part structure, similar to his three-act operas. Each part is further divided into 'scenes', which consist of individual numbers or 'movements'. These movements include recitatives, arias, and choruses.

What is the basis for many performing versions of Messiah?

The first published score of 1767, together with Handel's documented adaptations and recompositions of various movements, has been the basis for many performing versions since the composer's lifetime. Modern performances which seek authenticity tend to be based on one of three 20th-century performing editions.

What is a a cappella chorus in Messiah?

"And with His Stripes" is the first of only a small handful of choruses in Messiah in which the orchestral instruments simply double the voice parts. This is the original musical definition of a cappella style.

What was the size of the choir in John Tobin's Messiah performance?

In 1950 John Tobin conducted a performance of Messiah in St Paul's Cathedral with a choir of 60, a counter-tenor alto soloist, and modest attempts at vocal elaboration of the printed notes, in the manner of Handel's day.
