What solar rebates are available in Alberta?

Edmonton Solar Rebate - The City of Edmonton recently announced a rebate for residential solar installations for \$0.40/W up to \$4,000. This rebate is in addition to the provincially-funded residential and commercial solar program. Micro Generation - Micro generators in Alberta are subject to the Micro Generation Regulation guidelines.

Are there rebates for solar panels in Saskatchewan?

Additional energy incentive rebates and programs are offered within Saskatchewan not pertaining to solar panel installations. Good Energy Yukon - This solar power incentive in Yukon Territory offers a rebate of \$800 per installed kW to a maximum of \$5,000 per system per year.
