

How can I find free EV charging stations?

Our favorite and possibly the simplest option to find free EV charging stations is Plugshare. It has a filter letting you remove all chargers that require payment, and there's a map dedicated to finding free EV charging stations.

Are EV charging stations cheaper than gas stations?

Where can you get free car charging?
