

Are Airstream batteries too small?

One common issue among Airstream owners is that the batteries are too small. While most campers have 100 or 110 amp batteries, Airstream typically provides only 80 amp batteries. Additionally, Airstream does not provide a gauge to check battery levels.

Do Airstream travel trailers have batteries?

Airstream travel trailers typically come with two 12V batteries to help power the appliances and devices inside and outside of the trailer. Battery power isn't enough to operate the larger appliances such as the air conditioner all on its own, however. What are the batteries for?

Can you use a battery Jack on an Airstream?

Battery power is perfect for using a power jack to hitch and unhitch your trailer, keeping your towing lights on while you're in transit, and using the interior lights and other small appliances minimally while you're parked. Where are the batteries in an Airstream?

Can I leave batteries in my airstream during storage?

If you choose to leave your batteries in your Airstream during storage, you must keep them charged. This will require plugging the unit in or hooking up to a charge at least monthly. Batteries should be fully charged when placed in storage and maintained to keep batteries from freezing.


