

Why isn't my Baxi 105E combi boiler heating up?

If your Baxi 105E combi boiler is not providing hot water, or the water is only heating up when the central heating is turned on, it could be a problem with your diaphragm washer. The Fix: The diaphragm washer can be replaced using a service kit. It can be a fiddly job, so you may want to just replace the entire diverter valve.

Why is my Baxi boiler not working?

A common culprit for this fault on Baxi boilers is a lack of pressure. If your system is set lower than 1.5 bar then it won't operate correctly. Now, the quick fix is to top up the boiler pressure using the filling loop. And once you've topped up the boiler pressure, you'll need to reset the boiler.

What are the most common Baxi boiler problems?

This is one of the most common Baxi boiler problems, but it can also affect any other boiler brand out there. You turn on a tap or shower, and nothing happens. At best, you'll notice it only gets lukewarm, and that's with the heating on. The problem likely lies with the diverter valve, or a part in the diverter valve such as the diaphragm.

How do I reset my Baxi 2PF boiler?

To reset your Baxi 2PF boiler, turn the thermostat knob all the way to the 'off' or 'reset' mode, and then turn it back on. This should get the boiler going again. However, if the problem persists, it could be due to a faulty pump or blocked pipework, in which case you should call a heating engineer to investigate.

What should I do if my Baxi boiler keeps locking out?

If your Baxi boiler keeps locking out, DO NOT touch the top or try to brush or clean it. These particular Baxi models are prone to ignition problems and constant lockouts. The issue could be due to worn-out combustion chamber seals. The Fix: If the chamber seals are worn, degenerated, or split, replace them.

Yes, every new Baxi boiler comes with a warranty of 1 year as standard. However, depending on the model of your Baxi boiler, Baxi offers extended warranties ranging from 2 - 10 years. You can extend your Baxi boiler
