

What is BC Hydro EV charging?

The BC Hydro EV charging network spans British Columbia, offering fast and reliable electric vehicle (EV) charging at 153 units across 84 sites. Supported by partnerships with the Province of B.C. and Natural Resources Canada, the network aims to add 3,000 more charging ports over the next decade.

What is BC Hydro's electric vehicle charging station?

An electric vehicle charging station built and operated by BC Hydro. (BC Hydro) The ability to keep a battery-electric vehicle powered for free using BC Hydro's public charging infrastructure will come to an end later this week.

How much does BC Hydro charge per minute?

Starting on May 1, 2021, charging infrastructure operated by BC Hydro will come with fees, with rates of \$0.12 per minute for fast charging at 25 kW stations, \$0.21 per minute for fast charging at kW stations, and \$0.27 per minute for 100 kW stations.

Where can I charge an electric vehicle in BC?

One of the great things about an electric vehicle (EV) is that fueling up is as easy as plugging in. There are over 2,000 public places to charge an electric vehicle in B.C., including well over 100 fast-charging stations. Though the vast majority of charging takes place at home, you can find numerous public charging options throughout the province.

How many fast charging stations are there in BC?

BC Hydro has opened 13 new fast charging stations within the Lower Mainland. These stations are part of the 28 new stations BC Hydro has announced, allowing drivers of electric vehicles to take their car from Tofino to the BC-Alberta border.

Where is BC Hydro EV charging hub?

Located at the intersection of Pelmewash Parkway and Oyama Road in Oyama, Lake Country, this EV charging hub is home to a number of firsts - it is the largest in BC Hydro's network, it has BC Hydro's fastest charger at 350kW, and it is also the first BC Hydro station to feature North American Charging Standard (NACS) connectors.
