

Why is my Buick Envision key fob not working?

What battery does the Buick Envision key fob use?

The Buick Envision key fob uses the CR2032 battery like most other Buick car models. The CR2032 battery is a lithium-oxide battery that is coin or button-shaped. It has a diameter of 20mm and a thickness of 3.2 mm. It has a voltage of 3.0 volts. It is a primary non-rechargeable battery that has a typical weight of 3.0 grams.

Why does my Buick Envision key fob take a bath?

If your Buick Envision key fob has taken a bath in the soapy water of the washing machine after you forgot to take it out of your pants pocket, water damage is very likely. Your Envision key has rubber seals which prevents the water from getting to the electronic chip inside.

How do you replace a Buick key fob battery?

Use the metal key to pry open the key fob case. Remove the battery from the back cover. Install the new battery. Make sure the + side is facing the back cover. Line up the case and press it to close it. Slide in the metal key until it clicks. This Buick key fob requires one CR2032 battery.

How do I choose a new battery for my envision key fob?

Make sure the battery is facing in the right direction when inserting it. When purchasing a new battery for the key fob of your Envision, keep in mind that the battery may be sitting on the shelf for a long time. Therefore after replacement it may not work, or may not last that long. Try purchasing the battery from a store where stock moves fast.
