So, if your car is CCS-compatible, then you can usually use a CCS Tesla charger. This means that you can use a Tesla charger for other cars. Tesla also uses Type 2 connectors for its standard, non-Supercharger setups. Any car compatible ...

Can any non-Tesla use a Tesla Supercharger? Only electric cars equipped with a CCS connector can use a Supercharger. Hyundai IONIQ 5 and Kia EV6 owners have ...

If a Supercharger post has two cables or an installed adapter, other EVs can only charge with the CCS connector. Tesla is unable to accommodate vehicles that do not fully comply with CCS communication and safety protocols.
