Where can I charge a non-Tesla Electric Vehicle?

Most useful for Electric Vehicle (EV) drivers and owners will likely be Tesla destination chargers, most commonly found at hotels, parks, and shopping centers. These chargers are primarily designed for Tesla vehicles and it's unlikely they will allow for non-Tesla charging unless Tesla goes around and updates those chargers.

Can a non-Tesla electric vehicle charge at a Tesla Supercharger station?

Non-Tesla electric vehicles can charge at some Tesla Supercharger stations with the use of an adaptor such as the Magic Dock. You might think you need a Tesla to charge your electric vehicle at a Tesla station, but that is not the case.

Does Tesla have an EV charging network?

Tesla has invested a huge amount of money and resources into creating its own infrastructure and charging network for its vehicle owners - with the specialist EV manufacturer having installed over 1,000 Superchargers in the UK and Ireland since 2014. That makes it one of the most expansive EV charging network providers in the country.

How do I control charging at a Tesla charging station?

To control charging at a Tesla charging station, you'll need to download the Tesla app. Currently, non-Tesla EVs can access a portion of Tesla's Supercharging network if they're compatible, meaning they meet certain technical criteria:
