

What incentives are available for solar energy in Canada?

How many solar energy incentives are there in Alberta?

There are currently 7 solar energy incentives available in Alberta. This includes 5 rebates and 2 financing programs. Banff Solar Production Incentive - The Town of Banff currently offers a \$0.75 per watt rebate on solar energy systems, up to a maximum of 20kW. However, applications are limited each year.

What solar energy incentives are available in Nova Scotia?

There are currently 3 solar energy incentives available in Nova Scotia. This includes 1 rebate and 2 financing programs. SolarHomes Program - Efficiency Nova Scotia is currently offering a \$0.30 per watt rebate on the purchase of solar photovoltaic systems up to a maximum rebate of \$3,000.

Can you get a solar loan in Canada?

Canada Greener Homes Loan - As part of the Greener Homes Initiative, eligible homeowners can also receive a 10-year interest free loan of \$5,000 and up to \$40,000 to help finance their solar system. There are currently 7 solar energy incentives available in Alberta. This includes 5 rebates and 2 financing programs.

Are there solar rebates in Canada?

Provincial Rebates: There are provincial solar rebates and/or net metering programs available for businesses offered by most Canadian provinces. An example is New Brunswick's Energy Smart Commercial Buildings Retrofit Program, or Save on Energy grants available in Ontario for specific regions or sectors.

What solar energy incentives are available in Manitoba?

There are currently 3 solar energy incentives available in Manitoba. This includes 1 rebate and 1 financing program. Efficiency Manitoba Solar Rebate Program - Efficiency Manitoba offers a rebate of up to \$0.50 per watt, up to a maximum of 10 kilowatts or \$5,000 per home for residential solar systems.

Canada Greener Homes Grant (for existing applicants): grants up to \$5,000 to get part of your costs back for eligible home retrofits, plus up to \$600 additional grant toward the total costs of your pre and post retrofit EnerGuide home evaluations.
