

How can I find free EV charging stations?

How do I find free charging stations?

PlugShare: Filter your search to display only free charging stations by selecting "free" or "\$0" in the price filter. ChargePoint: Similar to PlugShare, use the app's filtering options to find zero-cost charging. ChargeHub: Discover free charging deals by adjusting the price filter within the app.
