

Where can I charge my electric car in Ireland?

Easygo.ie, the country's first privately-owned electric vehicle charging network, launched the DC charger at the Four Seasons Hotel in Monaghan on Monday. The Tritium Veefil-RT 50kW rapid charger can add 50km of range to an electric vehicle in 10 minutes, the company said.

How many EV charging stations are there in Ireland?

Electric vehicles or EV is a name that is currently gaining a lot of traction all around Ireland. There are currently more than 1100 EV charging stations across the entire island, with over 70 of them offering fast charging in the Republic alone.

How far is ecarNI from a rapid charger in Northern Ireland?

This means no-one in Northern Ireland is more than 30 miles from a rapid charger, making it possible to drive across the country easily on electric power alone. ecarNI's public charging points are owned and operated by ESB Group, an electricity company based in Ireland.

Where can I get a car charger in Ireland?

Where can I charge my ecarNI card in Belfast?

There are also a number of other public charging points, including a rapid charger at IKEA in Belfast, owned and operated by Ecotricity, and points at Asda supermarkets - although the ones at its Enniskillen and Bangor branches have three-pin plugs that aren't accessible with the ecarNI card.
