It first opened in 1847 together with the adjacent hotel, and was originally named Paragon Station. Today it has 6 platforms and is operated by Transpennine Express.

If using a Sat Nav please enter the postcode HU9 1TU. This will take you to Tower Street, Hull, which is the nearest main road to The Deep. The Deep has its own car park with its own pay and display car park, charges are £3.75 for 5 hours 6am-6pm and £2 6pm-6am. Charges apply every day including bank holidays.
