

Does Maine have a community solar program?

AUGUSTA, Maine -- Maine's community solar program, commonly known as net energy billing, has been wildly successful in incentivizing the development of small-scale solar power projects. They've popped up like mushrooms as developers chase the deals codified by state lawmakers, allowing them to sell power at a premium above market rates.

Does Central Maine Power have solar farms?

Central Maine Power offers solar farms as a green energy option for their customers. There are no annual fees, no cost to enroll, and no solar panels required on your home. What is Community Solar? It is the green energy option that makes solar available to renters and homeowners with no upfront costs.

How does central Maine Power pay for solar energy?

Central Maine Power credits you 15% discount for the solar electricity allocated to your account, based on your usage. Solar energy is then generated from our solar farms. You pay for the credits you received.

What is a Maine Community Solar Farm (CSF)?

Maine Community Solar Farms (CSF) allow Mainers who rent, live in apartments, or are unable to install solar panels to access the full benefits of going solar. By joining a ReVision Energy CSF in your utility territory, you can enjoy energy savings and clean solar power generated locally.

How does CMP solar work for Maine residents?

In Maine, CMP solar subscribers receive solar credits that reduce their monthly bill from Central Maine Power (CMP) from an average of \$100 to \$85. They receive a separate bill from Nexamp for the cost of generating the electricity, which comes with a 15 percent discount.

How does the Maine home use solar power?

On bright days, the Maine home's rooftop solar array generates four times as much energy as the house needs. The sun streams in through a wall of windows on the south side of the home. This excess energy is stored in batteries for use during cloudy days or at night. The homeowners only pay a connection fee of about \$13 a month to Central Maine Power.

Community Solar is available to renters and homeowners with eligible utilities in Maine. To participate in Community Solar with Arcadia, customers must create an account and have their utility bills managed by Arcadia so we may connect you to a project and correctly apply your solar savings.
