Are there EV charging stations in Massachusetts?

MassDEP, the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection, offers rolling grant programs to make electric vehicles (EVs) and EV charging stations more widely available in Massachusetts. Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until all available funding is spent.

Does Massachusetts support electric vehicle charging?

If you live in Massachusetts, you should know that there's support for electric vehicle charging installations too. The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) has implemented a few changes to their Massachusetts Electric Vehicle Incentive Program (MassEVIP) while also introducing a brand-new DC Fast Charging Station Program.

Electric Vehicle Charging Fee Increase. Effective April 15, 2025, the City of Cambridge will increase fees for public use of City-owned electric vehicle charging stations. Under the revised fee structure: EV drivers will pay \$0.28 per kilowatt-hour, an increase of \$.09 from the current rate

In 2022, over 45,000 hours of charging occurred at city-owned charging stations. As more publicly accessible chargers are installed, there will be less need for Across Sidewalk Electric Vehicle Charging permits to be issued. The city will evaluate the Charging Pilot Program through 2024, to determine its future feasibility.
