How can I charge a non-Tesla vehicle?

To charge a non-Tesla vehicle using a Tesla charger, non-Tesla drivers must use at least version 4.18.0 of the Tesla app. Press the 'Charge Your Non-Tesla' option and a prompt will ask you to add a payment method to begin charging. Other electric cars can use CCS common connections with Tesla's Superchargers.

Can I use other electric cars with Tesla Chargers?

Yes, other electric cars can use Tesla chargers with the help of adapters. Tesla chargers, including the Mobile Connector, Wall Connector, and Destination Charger, can accommodate J1772 EVs with the use of Tesla to J1772 charger adapters.

Can a non Tesla EV use a supercharger?

Other electric vehicles can use CCS common connections with Tesla Superchargers. Yes, non-Tesla electric cars can use Tesla chargers with Tesla-to-J1772 adapters. There isn't an official per kWh price for non-Tesla EVs using Superchargers yet, but rates will vary depending on the location.

Tesla's chargers are designed specifically for Tesla vehicles and use a proprietary charging protocol that is not compatible with other EVs. What charger does a Tesla not use?

All EVs sold in North America, except for Teslas, use the J1772 connector for charging. Think of Teslas as the iPhones of the EV world with the proprietary Lightning charger, while all non-Tesla vehicles are the Androids using the generic USB-C charger.

Does Tesla charge at a Supercharger station?

Tesla owners are billed for charging by the minute or kilowatt-hour for "supercharging" subject to local law. While Tesla drivers have the company's Level 3 and newer Supercharger stations exclusively right now, they can charge at most any EV charging station that utilizes adaptor cables.

Only electric cars fitted with a CCS-type plug can use a Tesla Supercharger, while Destination chargers use a standard Type 2 connector, which should be compatible with most electric cars. A...
