Where can I find EV charging stations in Hawaii?

The best way to find available charging stations is through Plugshare.com. Enter 'Hawaii', or your zip code to find all of the stations on your island. This app lists the location of most or all stations, including private ones that are available to EV owners.

Does Honolulu have a charging station?

The city of Honolulu in Hawaii, United States, has 348 public charging station ports (Level 2 and Level 3) within 15km. 88% of the ports are level 2 charging ports and 33% of the ports offer free charges for your electric car. Honolulu is the biggest city and Capital of Hawaii State.

How many EV chargers are there in Hawaii?

The scarcity of EV chargers, at least in comparison to the number of EVs on the islands makes sense, given the Aloha State's geographical limitations. Despite being 2,000 miles from the contiguous United States, Hawaii still has more registered EVs (10,670) than several other states combined.

Do electric cars have charge ports?

Electric cars have charge ports and adapters that allow for use of the available public charging stations around our state. These chargers include 'Level 2' (240v charging stations) and 'Level 3' (DC Fast Chargers).

How many charging stations does Electric Island have?

First announced in December 2020, Electric Island opens with eight vehicle charging stations (a majority of which are available for public use) for the charging of electric cars, buses, box vans and semi-trucks.

To make electric cars viable in the Big Island, charging stations would need to be made available in areas where no gas stations currently exist. And then, there is the cost of electricity.
