

What is Bowling Green's new electric vehicle battery Gigafactory?

BOWLING GREEN, Ky. -- Executives from Envision AESC break ground on a \$2 billion state-of-the-art electric vehicle battery gigafactory in Bowling Green's Kentucky Transpark. Envision AESC's investment will create 2,000 full-time jobs in the region to operate its 30 gigawatt-hour plant, which has the potential to expand to 40 gigawatt-hours.

How many vehicles will envision power in Bowling Green?
