

How does FPL offer solar energy?

One of the ways FPL has offered solar energy to customers is through its SolarTogether program. SolarTogether is a way for FPL customers to directly support solar projects installed in the state.

What is FPL SolarNow?

FPL SolarNow is a community solar program that brings solar power to Florida through hundreds of solar arrays across the state. With the support of dedicated participants, it enables customers to benefit from solar energy without installing panels on their own property.

What is FPL's solartogether program?

FPL says the SolarTogether program allows subscribers to enjoy the benefits of renewable energy without a large upfront cost or commitment of installing solar on their own roof. In fact, SolarTogether admits anyone who is an FPL customer, including renters, to join.

What are the benefits of FPL SolarTogether &#174;?

FPL SolarTogether &#174; is a collaborative community effort, which makes going solar easy for everyone. Designed with convenience and budget in mind, the program empowers you to start your solar journey in a way that fits your life, without the hassle and upfront costs of rooftop panels.

When can FPL customers sign up for the solartogether program?

FPL customers can sign up for the SolarTogether program starting March 17, 2020. They will then have the option to choose how much of their energy they would like to offset with solar power, up to 100%.

How much does FPL solar cost per kilowatt?

The subscription rate is a fixed \$6.76 per month per kilowatt subscribed, with a credit rate of 3 cents per kilowatt. This means that, on average, participants in the program can save just over \$6 per month on their electricity bills. The program is only available to customers who are enrolled in FPL's voluntary solar partnership program, SolarNow.
