

How can I find free EV charging stations?

Our favorite and possibly the simplest option to find free EV charging stations is Plugshare. It has a filter letting you remove all chargers that require payment, and there's a map dedicated to finding free EV charging stations.

How much does it cost to charge an EV at home?

This map provides a comprehensive view of all free charging stations, making it easier to plan your trips without incurring additional costs. Charging an EV at home costs around \$0.17 per kWh on average, while public charging stations charge on average about \$0.29 per kWh - about 70% more than home charging.
