

Can a non-profit get a solar energy grant?

Aside from nonprofits, USDA High Energy Cost Grants may be available to state and local government entities as well as federally recognized tribes.

How do I find solar grants for my nonprofit?

To find solar grants for your nonprofit, we suggest beginning with federally available opportunities and slowly identifying local incentives, rebates, and offers. Unfortunately, since almost all nonprofits are tax-exempt, the federal solar investment tax credit (ITC) cannot be applied to most organizations' solar purchases.

Can a nonprofit receive funding for solar panels?

If a nonprofit has the resources, this may be a great fit. This grant from the United States Department of Treasury reimburses some of the costs associated with investing in solar panels for nonprofits instead of providing tax credits.

Do nonprofits require energy grants?
