

What is 'Solar Power' by Lorde?

'Solar Power' is the new single by Lorde, released in June after a four-year hiatus. The song received mixed reactions upon its release, with many comparing it to George Michael's 'Freedom! '90' and Primal Scream's 'Loaded'.

On June 18, the George Michael Estate released a statement on the late singer's official website giving Lorde the estate's blessing.
