

Who started the first solar power plant in Pangasinan?

LINGAYEN,PANGASINAN--The Provincial Government of Pangasinan and Citicore Renewable Energy Corporation(CREC) laid the groundwork for the first solar power plant at Barangay Santa Catalina,Binalonan. Governor Ramon V. Guico III and CREC President and CEO Oliver Y. Tan led the ceremonial groundbreaking ceremony on March 20,2024.

What is Pangasinan solar?

This allowed ACEN to fast-track the development of Pangasinan Solar, with a potential expansion of up to 100 MW. Pangasinan Solar aims to boost Pangasinan's local economy with the creation of an estimated 1,000 jobs during the plant's construction phase.
