What does the orange light on Xbox One mean?

The orange light means that your console is on standby and it's not receiving sufficient power to turn on the console. Xbox One comes with built-in surge protection that protects the console from electrical damage. Once a power surge is detected, your console will enter into a surge mode and cut the power supply.

Why is my power supply Orange on Xbox One?

The orange light on your power supply should disappear. After waiting for a while, plug in your Xbox One as well as the power supply and then try starting it to see if the issue persists. Having a clean power supply is always a good sign as it prevents several power issues from occurring.

How do I fix a power supply brick on my Xbox One?

When you run into problems with your power supply brick, Microsoft recommends power cycling your console. You might be able to soft reset the power supply this way, which might fix your problem. Power cycling the console is as follows: Disconnect the power cable from your console that connects to your wall adapter or surge protector.
