

When is trash collected in Fayetteville NC?

For normal trash collection schedules, visit fayettevillenc.gov/solid-waste Here you can see the city-observed holidays. Friday's Household Waste & Yard Waste will be collected Friday, Nov 10. Bulky items are collected on the same day as your regular yard waste. Bulky items are collected on B weeks.

How much does a rollout cart cost in Fayetteville?

This rollout cart remains the property of the City of Fayetteville and cannot be removed from the residence to which it is assigned. Residents can purchase an additional brown 96-gallon rollout cart for a fee of \$60. Once purchased, this rollout cart becomes the property of the resident and can be used for household waste or yard waste.

When is Fayetteville's loose-leaf recycling program?

Friday's recycling will be collected Saturday, Dec. 27 The City of Fayetteville's loose-leaf collection program is operated by Fayetteville-Cumberland Parks & Recreation. It is a great service for residents during the fall season. Place leaves and pine straw behind the curb away from storm drains and out of the road.

Is Fayetteville a sustainable city?

In 2009, the City of Fayetteville adopted a Sustainability Master Plan (PDF, 69KB) that addresses the broad definition of sustainability and incorporates the environment, social equity, and the economy. This approach is often referred to as the triple bottom line.

In addition to the new trash and recycling guidelines, Fayetteville is limiting household yard waste to 10 containerized items per week. Yard waste can be collected in 96-gallon green or brown rollout carts; any 32-gallon can ...
