

What is a solid waste container?

Solid waste does not necessarily mean solid material, but rather anything that can be discarded without causing harm to human health and the environment. The following containers are typically used to haul non-toxic waste, such as garbage, debris, scrap, ocean/lake water and recyclable materials.

Why is solid waste collection so expensive?

Collection of solid wastes is one of the most costly functional elements, because of high cost of fuel and labor. Various types of collection services now used for municipal, commercial, and industrial sources. The most common municipal collection systems are curb, alley and backyard collection.

What is a solid waste collection service?

The collection service provided to large apartment buildings, residential complexes and commercial and industrial activities typically centered on the use of large movable and stationary containers. Curb Service (kerb-side): The house owner is responsible for placing the solid waste containers at the curb on the scheduled day.

How does a garbage collection truck collect waste?

Most garbage collection trucks use an automated electronic arm to grab and empty waste cans. This efficient process streamlines collection and prevents potential injuries. To ensure proper collection, it's important to place your trash, recyclables, or yard waste correctly.

By the 1970s, once per week (1/wk) collection was common in half of the U.S. This trend continued into the 1980s but at a reduced rate.

How to collect municipal waste?

In the future it appears that the use of large containers which can be emptied mechanically with an articulated container pick up mechanism will be the most common method used for the collection of municipal wastes.
