

Can a Tesla Supercharger charge a non-Tesla EV?

It depends on the type of Supercharger and whether your car has an NACS charger or adapter. Any non-Tesla EV except for the Nissan Leaf and Mitsubishi Outlander PHEV (which use an incompatible plug standard called CHAdeMO) can currently charge at one of the limited number of Tesla Superchargers that offers a Magic Dock adapter.

As of last week, Ford EVs are able to charge anywhere in Tesla's entire Supercharger network, thanks to a new adapter the EV owner will carry. Does Tesla have an EV charging network?
