

Can I use a tube preamp with a solid state amp?

A tube preamp with 1 k ohm output impedance feeding a solid state amp with 47 k ohm input impedance should be just fine. Related tube pre-amps may typically use an output capacitor to couple to the amplifier. Again keep plenty of impedance in the solid state amp so this doesn't cause a roll off in the bass. One final area that used to be a problem.

Does tube preamp work with SS amplifiers?

As others have noted, it can and does work very well, but you will have to ascertain that the tube preamp output can properly drive the input impedance of your SS amplifier. Tube preamplifiers typically have higher output impedance than their SS brethren, but that varies greatly from one model to another.

What does an SS pre-amp do?

Your question is a bit confusing. An SS pre-amp (like any pre-amp) does what it's supposed to- it gives you inputs, tone controls, balance and volume to the tube amp. I run an SS pre-amp and power amp to my tube-amp- lots of control over the sound.

Does tube preamp work?

Lots of variables, but many have done it with positive results. As others have noted, it can and does work very well, but you will have to ascertain that the tube preamp output can properly drive the input impedance of your SS amplifier.

Is Yamaha a solid state preamp?

The Yamaha is solid state. Now, I know that there are real advantages in using a tube preamp on the mike recording end of things, but do not know what the use of a SS preamp on the output phase would do to the sound. Are there any pros or cons about this.

What preamp sounded most pleasing to your ears?

Sometimes it was a tube preamp with one of several SS Amps. or a SS preamp with a tube amp. Later on I learned of impedance issues that might arise from mixing but back then it was more about what pleased my ears. The one thing that sounded most pleasing to my ears was a tube preamp hooked to a solid state amp.

So use a solid state amp with 47 k ohm or higher input impedance. Use a tube pre with a lower output impedance (not hard to find one with only 300 ohms), and don't get a tube ...
