Does Tesla have a supercharger network?

Here's how we got here. In a major win for EV drivers, Tesla is opening up its Supercharger network to all non-Tesla EVs. So far, ten brands can power up at select stations: Ford, Rivian, General Motors (GM), Polestar, Volvo, Nissan, Lucid, Mercedes-Benz, and--as of this week--Hyundai and Genesis.

Does Tesla have an EV charging network?

Tesla has invested a huge amount of money and resources into creating its own infrastructure and charging network for its vehicle owners - with the specialist EV manufacturer having installed over 1,000 Superchargers in the UK and Ireland since 2014. That makes it one the most expansive EV charging network providers in the country.

Are Tesla Superchargers opening up to EV owners?

Now that other automakers plan to adopt Tesla's plug design, Superchargers are opening up to most EV owners. Ford is the first to gain access. Some background, if you need it. Early last year, Ford announced plans to incorporate Tesla's NACS port in its future EVs.

Are all Tesla Superchargers open to non-Tesla EVs?

Not all Superchargers are currently open to non-Tesla vehicles. Within the Tesla app, use the map to locate nearby Supercharger stations compatible with non-Tesla EVs. In the UK, Tesla has opened a good number of stations for this purpose, especially along major motorways and in city centers, so you should have options nearby.

Why does Ford only charge at Tesla stations?

Ford found that its drivers power up at Tesla stations only 20% of the time. Adapter availability, wait times, or charge port placement issues could be to blame. The cables that run from the Supercharger to the car are too short to reach the port on some non-Tesla vehicles, such as Fords.

How do you charge a Tesla?

When you arrive at an open Supercharger station, park in a spot designated for non-Tesla vehicles. Once plugged in, open the Tesla app, select the Supercharger location, and start the session to begin charging. The app will handle the payment, and you can monitor your session's progress, just as a Tesla owner would.
